



# Varicose Vein and Thread Vein Prices

## Microsclerotherapy for Thread Veins

The procedure involves injecting a chemical, called a sclerosant, into your thread vein using a very fine needle and this closes the thread vein and it eventually fades. Three or four treatments, separated by eight weeks, will usually be required to achieve the required degree of fading.

### How much will it cost?

Consultation fees from **£170** for an initial appointment.

Procedure cost per session from **£270**.

A diagnostic scan may be performed during treatment, cost of scan from **£300**.

## Ultrasound-Guided Foam Sclerotherapy

Foam sclerotherapy, performed under the guidance of ultrasound, is often used to treat varicose veins near the skin's surface. A non-surgical, minimally-invasive technique, ultrasound guided sclerotherapy with foam is designed to close varicose veins causing the problem vein to shrink or possibly disappear.

### How much will it cost?

Consultation fees from **£170** for an initial appointment.

Procedure cost for treatment from **£1,140**.

## The VenaSeal or “superglue”

The VenaSeal or “superglue” treatment is a new way of closing the main vein in the leg that causes varicose veins.

The VenaSeal closure system is a procedure that uses a proprietary medical adhesive delivered to close the vein. This unique approach eliminates the risk of nerve injury when treating the small vein, administered without the use of anesthesia, avoiding patient discomfort associated with multiple needle sticks.

### How much will it cost?

Consultation fees from **£170** for an initial appointment.

Unilateral (one leg) procedure cost from **£3,500**.

Bilateral (two legs in two stages) procedure cost from **£6,650**.

Bilateralsingle procedure (two legs in one stage) procedure from **£6,400**.

## Surgical ligation/stripping

This is a day case procedure usually performed under a general anaesthetic. Your surgeon may disconnect the superficial veins from the deep veins in your legs through an incision in your groin or the back of your knee. They will probably make many small cuts along the length of the varicose veins and remove them.

### How much will it cost?

The cost of this procedure is from **£2,500**.

## Radiofrequency ablation of veins (VNUS)

The VNUS Closure Procedure, offers patients an efficient, minimally invasive alternative for treating varicose veins to improve the skin’s appearance and to reduce health risks related to large varicose veins. The procedure utilizes radiofrequency (RF) energy to heat and contract the collagen found inside the vein walls, causing the vein to collapse and seal shut.

### How much will it cost?

The cost of this procedure is from **£2895**.
